## POLICY ON PAYMENT

Music fees are listed on the Application Form. Rates vary due to the time allocated to different grades.

- 1. <u>There are two payment dates: April 6, 2023, and December 01, 2023.</u> The Application Form must be returned with the first instalment which is half of the payment for the Academic Year September 2023 to May 2024. Your daughter/son will be allocated their teacher on a first come basis. <u>At the first lesson of term in September, each student must present receipt as proof of payment, otherwise lessons will not commence. We will adhere strictly to this rule in September.</u>
- 2. Please note it is **most important** that the Application Form is returned by the date specified as contracts and number of students must be arranged by May with the current staff for September. (Should demand exceed availability it will be necessary to employ more staff. This needs to be done well in advance of the new term.). Your co-operation would be greatly appreciated in this regard as our numbers are on the increase.
- 3. Should a student cancel lessons during the year, the fee will be forfeited as the music lesson is part of the teacher's agreed contract for the year.

#### **CODE OF BEHAVIOUR**

- 1 A high standard of conduct is expected of all students inside and outside of St Angela's Academy of Music. (The agreement regarding the Code of Behaviour is attached to the Application Form and must be signed by both student and parent/guardian)
- 2 Students must always be punctual for their music lesson. On arrival they should knock on the door of the Music Room and enter.
- 3 Students should always come well prepared for their music lesson with their music and homework copy. This copy is also necessary for communicating with parents regarding progress when necessary and for recording what must be practised before the next lesson.
- 4 We expect our students to be always well mannered, gracious, dignified, and respectful to their teachers and their peers. Students should never behave in a manner that compromises their dignity or brings their name into disrepute.
- 5 There is a **No Smoking** policy in the Music School. Chewing gum is not allowed.
- 6 Alcohol, drugs, and any illegal substance are strictly forbidden and may not be brought on to the Music School premises under any circumstances. Any breach of this rule will have serious consequences and parents will be notified immediately.
- 7 Students must respect all property of the Music school and must never bring food into the premises. Defacing property by writing or scratching on instruments, furniture, walls etc or by putting graffiti on any part of the music school premises is a very serious offence and <u>students will be held</u> <u>responsible for the repair of the damage.</u>

#### ABSENTEEISM

Absenteeism has become a big problem with <u>some students.</u> Teachers find it extremely difficult to accommodate them at other times, so a few ground rules are necessary.

- 1. Students should present themselves at the appointed time for their lesson every week.
- 2. No student should ever go as a supporter to a match if she/he has a music lesson on that day. If a student opts to attend the match or go home early, she/he will have to forego that music lesson.
- 3. In the event of a student being ill, parents should make **direct contact with the teacher** on the previous day if possible. The teacher will do their best to facilitate the student but sometimes it may not be possible to make up lessons at such short notice. The teacher may suggest doing an online lesson.
- 4. If a teacher misses a lesson, it will be made up at a time that is mutually convenient.
- 5. T Y students must give timely notice of work experience and outings at least two weeks in advance. Much more co-operation on the part of the student is needed in this area.
- 6. In the event of strike days in Primary or Second Level, music teachers will still be present to give lessons and it is the responsibility of every student to attend.
